

<p>*The Office of Special Education Programs is transferring the burden from OMB clearance 1820-0689, currently cleared through April 2013, to OPEPD/PIMS. These data will be collected through ED<i>Facts</i> beginning with the FFY2011 data. Two years ago when OSEP initiated this collection, the estimated burden for the collection of Table 8 was based on a calculation that assumed that no LEAs/States collected the data at that time, although there was evidence that some states were in fact already gathering these data from LEAs. OSEP erred on the side of over-estimating rather than under-estimating the burden. We expect this burden has been reduced over the past two years, and will be further reduced once the data are collected through ED<i>Facts</i>. A revised burden estimate will be determined during the next three-year clearance cycle for ED<i>Facts</i>, which is scheduled to begin later this summer. In addition to the data transfer from OSEP, there are additional technical amendments to ED<i>Facts</i> that are detailed in Attachment H2.</p>
