Performance Measures

Information must be collected to ensure program efficacy and appropriate use of government funds. Applicants that receive funding under this solicitation must provide data that measure the results of their work. Any award recipient will be required, post award, to provide the data requested in the "Data Grantee Provides" column so that VA can calculate values for the "Performance Measures" column. Performance measures for this solicitation are as follows:

- 1. Record of time expended.
- 2. Record of grant funds expended.
- 3. Trips completed.
- 4. Total distance covered.
- 5. Veterans served.

- 6. Locations serviced.
- 7. Veteran satisfaction survey. (Provided by VA)

Submission of performance measures data is not required for the application. Instead, applicants must discuss in their application their proposed methods for collecting data for performance measures. Please refer to the section "What an Application Should Include" (below) for additional information.

Note on project evaluations: Applicants that propose to use funds awarded through this solicitation to conduct project evaluations should be aware that certain project evaluations (such as systematic investigations designed to develop or contribute to knowledge) may constitute "research." However, project evaluations that are intended only to generate internal improvements to a program or service, or are conducted only to meet VA's performance measure data reporting requirements likely do not constitute "research." Research is subject to applicable VA human subjects protections.

Applicants should provide sufficient information for VA to determine whether the particular project they propose would either intentionally or unintentionally collect and/or use information in such a way that it meets the VA regulatory definition of research.

Research, for the purposes of VA-funded programs, is defined as, "a systematic investigation, including research development, testing, and evaluation, designed to develop or contribute to generalizable knowledge." 28 C.F.R. § 46.102(d).
