NORC Field Staff Instruction and Script: If potential participant responds yes to all four questions, NORC field staff should respond, “You are eligible for participation in the study. I will now go through the verbal informed consent (next page) to tell you more about the study and what is expected of you for your participation as well as what you will be compensated for your participation in this study.” If potential participant responds no to any of the four questions, NORC field staff should respond, “Thank you for your interest in this study. Unfortunately, you are not eligible to participate at this time.”
