<p>The second follow-up full scale data collection for the Baccalaureate and Beyond Longitudinal Study of 2008/2012 (B&amp;B:08/12) is currently underway (July 2012 through March 2013). The primary purpose of the B&amp;B series of studies is to describe the various paths of recent college graduates into employment and additional education. Baseline data for the B&amp;B:08 cohort were collected as part of the National Postsecondary Student Aid Study (NPSAS:08). The first follow-up interview (B&amp;B:08/09) collected information from respondents one year after they received their bachelor's degree; the second follow-up (B&amp;B:08/12) is collecting data four years after bachelor's degree receipt. Interview data are supplemented with a variety of administrative data sources, including the Central Processing System (CPS), the National Student Loan Data System (NSLDS), and the National Student Clearinghouse (NSC). This change requests is to make a change to the incentive procedure that was approved as part of the B&amp;B:08/12 responsive design model, to increase response rates. We are requesting to re-allocate a portion of the total incentive amount offered to potential respondents, so that \$5 is prepaid and the balance paid upon interview completion.</p>
