WORK EXPERIENCE: When listing your work experience, show only the last 10 years of employment. If you are retired, describe the last 10 years you worked before you retired.

LANGUAGES: An ability to speak and understand a foreign language most likely will be used to greet and possibly guide foreign visitors. You would not be expected to explain highly technical aspects of the National Archives at New York City. Reading and translating duties might involve assisting the staff in reading and responding to foreign language correspondence or in translating documents from the holdings of the National Archives at New York City.

SPECIAL SKILLS: The information you provide will help us to identify which activities at the National Archives at New York City office will most interest you and where you can make the greatest contribution to our program. Please mark those activities on the list with which you have experience and indicate your level of expertise. Please add any other activities in which you have experience that you think will fit into the National Archives at New York City's program.

AVAILABILITY: Which days of the week and which hours on those days will you usually be available to volunteer your services? On occasions, volunteers will be needed in the evening.
