i3. In about 12 months, the researchers will contact you again by phone and ask you about topics such as your relationships with your partner, your interactions with your child or children, your relationship with other family members, your employment, and services you receive.

At that time, you may also be asked to participate in focus groups, in-person interviews, and to complete check lists about interactions with your child. Researchers may also ask if it's alright to interview your child. We will provide more information about these activities later, and your participation is voluntary.
