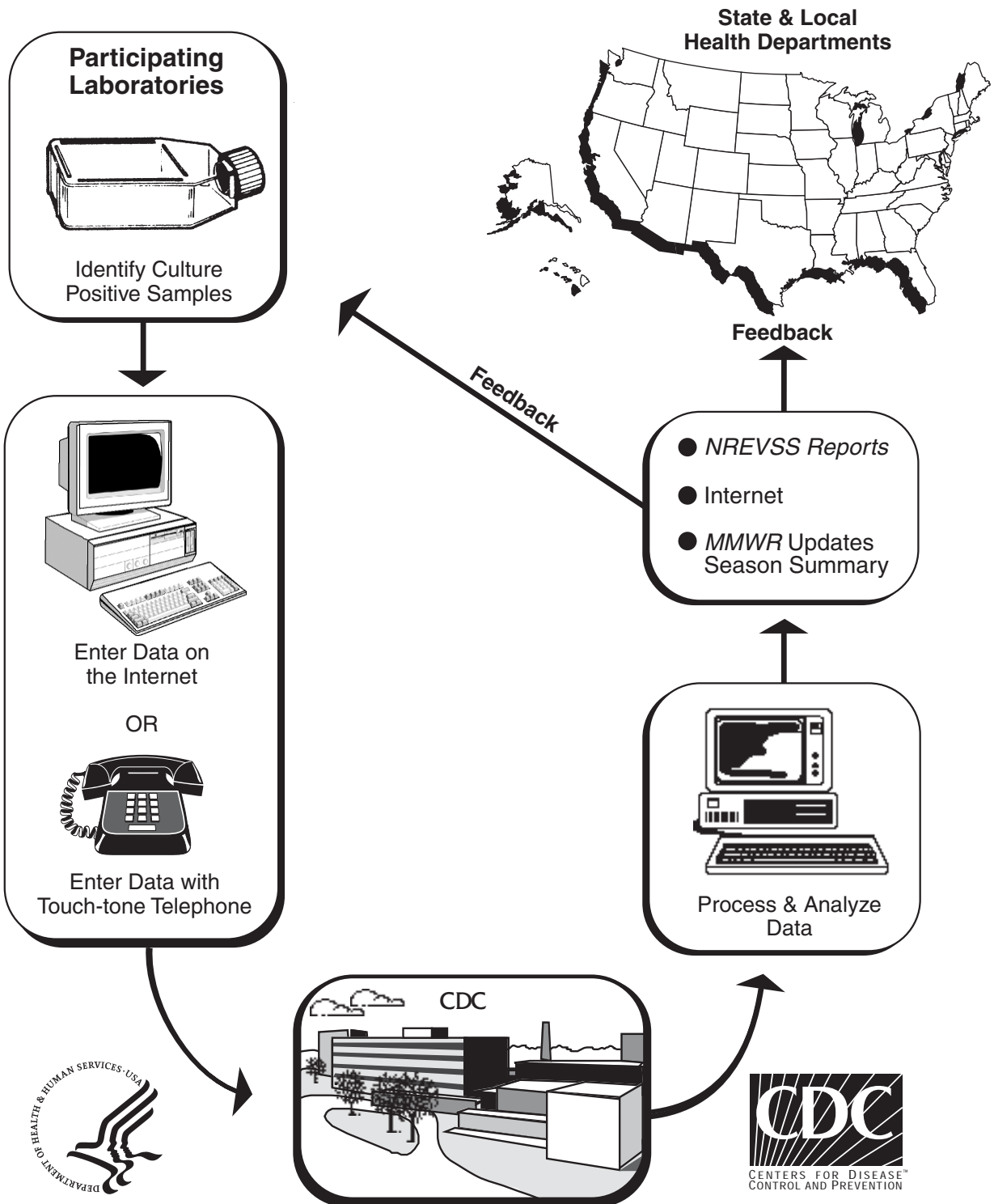

INSTRUCTIONS FOR TELEPHONE REPORTING:

1. Please call in once a week, anytime between **12 noon on Saturday and 12 noon on Tuesday** to be included in the latest week's report.
2. Use a touch tone telephone to Dial **1-800-232-0038**. If you get a busy signal, wait a few minutes and call again.
3. Once you are connected you will hear a short welcome message and instructions on reporting, shown in the example below.
4. To speed data entry, press the pound **#** key after entering a number to immediately move to the next question.
