A written evaluation report will be prepared that will contain information from the interviews and from other sources. Unless permission is obtained, the individual comments will not be identified in the report.

Taking part in this interview is voluntary. You may choose either to participate or not participate in the interview. NO matter what decision you make, there will be no penalty to you. Your relationship with the NCI and EGRP will be affected by your decision.
