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**Punishment For Unlawful Statements**

Potential claimants should keep in mind that it is unlawful to "knowingly and willfully" make any "materially false, fictitious, or fraudulent statements or representation" to a Federal agency. Violations can be punished under Section 2 of the False Statements Accountability Act of 1996 by a fine and/or imprisonment of not more than 5 years. 18 U.S.C. § 1001.
