Your Monthly Earnings

Usually, if you make more than the earnings limit, which in 2011 is \$14,160, we have to hold back some of your Social Security. But if we know how much you earned before taxes in each month in 2011, we may be able to pay you more.

The same is true of self-employed people. The difference is that we need to know how many hours you worked in each month, instead of the amount of money you earned.

For the following months in 2011, you previously told us that you would not earn over \$1,180 and would not work over 45 hours in self-employment.
