ABC Telco hereby accepts \$7,750,000 of its eligible funding for Connect America Fund Phase I incremental support for 2012.<sup>1</sup> To satisfy its deployment obligation in connection with this funding, ABC Telco will deploy broadband to 10,000 locations.
