Supporting Statement to Accompany SF-83I

A. Justification

1. The Office of Federal Financial Management (OFFM) leads efforts at governmentwide grants management to assure that Federal grants to non-Federal parties are managed properly and spent in accordance with laws and regulations. Working cooperatively with Federal grant-making agencies and non-Federal parties, OFFM establishes policies and guidelines through OMB's grants management circulars.
