III.	<b>TART CHERRIES</b> : all tart cherry varieties grown in the production area are classified as <i>Prunus cerasus</i> , <i>Prunus cerasus</i> by <i>Prunus avium</i> , or <i>Prunus cerasus</i> by <i>Prunus fruticosa</i> .
IV.	<b>PERSONS ELIGIBLE TO VOTE:</b> Any business entity currently engaged in the commercial freezing or canning of tart cherries produced in the designated area during the representative period of, 20, through, 20, is entitled to cast one ballot.
	Each separate business unit, partnership, LLC, family enterprise, corporation, association, estate, or firm that is a member of the cooperative association is entitled to one vote. Proxy voting is not authorized.
