In order to serve its clients better, HUD has made the following non material change:		
HUD's Office of Housing Counseling is seeking approval to simplify form HUD-9902, Housing Counseling Agency Activity Report, to improve data quality, decrease data element reporting for housing counseling agencies (HCAs), and to focus on key program outcomes. The performance data collection instrument for the Housing Counseling Program ("Program") will continue to be collected and can be automatically populated by HUD's Housing Counseling System (HCS) based on submitted client level data through HCAs' use of a Client Management System (CMS).		
The proposed form HUD-9902 is decreasing agency reporting from approximately 76 data elements currently required to be entered by the HCAs into their CMS to approximately 33 data elements. This decrease amounts to a 56% reduction in data elements that		
need to be manually input. The simplified reporting tool allows agencies to select multiple short- and long-term impacts applicable to each household served. Rather than capturing every possible outcome within each counseling type with the current 76 data elements, the proposed 33 data elements focus on key outcomes that more accurately demonstrate the impact of the Program.		
Interested CMS vendors will update their systems if they want housing counseling agencies to use their systems.
