**Hospital Quality Reporting Program Notice of Participation (Pledge Form) - Acknowledgment**

The hospital agrees to follow procedures for participating in the Hospital Quality Reporting Program as outlined in the federal regulations found in the Federal Register, or to indicate its decision to decline participation.

Each hospital must complete this "Hospital OR Notice of Participation" as outlined in the Hospital OR Reference Checklist on QualityNet and in the federal regulations found in the Federal Register. In an effort to alleviate the burden associated with submitting this form annually, effective with the Hospital OR Notice submitted for participation in FY 2009 or later, a hospital that indicated its intent to participate will be considered an active Hospital OR participant. CMS determines a need to pledge again, or the hospital submits a withdrawal to CMS.

This information is in compliance with the CMS guidelines for hospitals submitting their quality performance data in accordance with Section 509(b) of the Deficit Reduction Act of 2005. Hospitals that do not follow the guidelines as outlined in the federal regulations may receive a reduction of 2.0 percent in their Medicare Annual Payment Update (APU) for the applicable fiscal year. In order to avoid the reduction in their Annual Payment Update, hospitals must also continue to display quality information for public viewing as required by section 1886(b)(2)(B)(i)(V) of the Social Security Act. Before this information is displayed, hospitals will be permitted to review their information as file recorded. Based on section 1886(b)(2)(B)(i)(V) of the Social Security Act for payments beginning with FY2009, CMS is required to add other measures that affect conditions among affected parties. Eligible hospitals must follow the regulations as outlined in the federal regulations, and as summarized in the Hospital OR Reference Checklist on QualityNet.

In order to receive the full market basket update, CMS must publish on Hospital Compare the hospital's submitted data for the required measures. Data aggregated at the hospital level will be provided to the Secretary.
