1. Company Name

Provide the formal name of your organization for future reference.

2. NAICS Code

Provide the [North American Industry Classification System](#) (NAICS) number classifying your business. Supply up to three NAICS codes (at the three-digit level) and the respective industry types that describe the breadth of your organization’s operations.

3. Company Description

Provide 2-3 sentences describing your company. Limit description text to 80-words or less.

4. Number of Plants Involved

Provide the number of plants in your portfolio that are covered by your pledge. This will not be displayed on your web profile, unless you want it to be. DOE collects this for internal tracking purposes.

5. Logo

Provide a file with your company’s high-resolution logo as an attachment for placement on your web profile.

File type options: *high resolution* .eps, ai or .jpg


6. Contacts (optional)

Questions 7 and 8 may be answered after your company has achieved some notable successes through Better Plants to share.


7. **Successes** *(optional)*

Provide a summary of the energy savings achieved by your company. DOE recommends including the cumulative energy intensity improvement accomplished through the program (as of baseline year), though this information is optional. New companies can describe past successes, but should not report a cumulative percent improvement until the organization has submitted an annual report to DOE. Limit text to 200 words

Provide links to case studies and publications co-authored with DOE that highlight energy projects or best practices. Include links to DOE-affiliated activities such as webinar presentations, conferences, and other meetings. Links must be to the DOE website.
