NASS is a non-regulatory agency within the USDA. We collect and publish unbiased data that is used in making objective decisions. The National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH) is mandated by Congress to conduct research and make recommendations for the prevention of work-related diseases, illnesses, and injuries. Through a cooperative agreement, NIOSH has asked NASS to collect this vital information on worker exposure to pesticides so that NIOSH can determine if there is a need for additional follow-up studies to insure the safety of the American farmers and their families.
