

## Appendix 2: Hand Hygiene Observation Tool

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GUIDE TO HAND HYGIENE OPPORTUNITIES

<b>HIGH RISK FOR TRANSMISSION</b>	
Perform hand hygiene before and after each of the following tasks	
<b>DIRECT PATIENT CONTACT</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Bathing and mouth care</li> <li>• Wound care or dressing changes</li> <li>• Repositioning patient</li> <li>• Direct patient assessment or care</li> <li>• Specimen collection (blood, urine, stool, sputum)</li> <li>• Toileting activities</li> <li>• Physiotherapy activities</li> <li>• Invasive procedures (including, but not limited to, insertion of central or peripheral intravascular devices, lumbar puncture, intubation/ extubation, bladder catheterization, etc)</li> </ul>
<b>MODERATE RISK FOR TRANSMISSION *</b>	
Perform hand hygiene between patients	
<b>INDIRECT PATIENT CONTACT</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Preparing and administering medications</li> <li>• Touching patient equipment at the bedside (eg. Blood pressure cuffs, thermometers) but no patient contact</li> <li>• Transporting patient in a wheelchair or stretcher</li> <li>• After handling patient soiled linens</li> <li>• Before handling food</li> </ul>
<b>LOW RISK FOR TRANSMISSION *</b>	
Perform hand hygiene periodically	
<b>ENVIRONMENTAL CONTACT</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Charting or log book entry</li> <li>• Attendance at rounds</li> <li>• Handling stock linens or supplies</li> <li>• After personal toileting</li> </ul>
