- O **INCENTIVE:** If you qualify for this study, we will pay you \$60 to help us complete this research.
- **RTI/RSS:** RTI International is a nonprofit research organization (or RSS is a contract research firm). The Census Bureau contracted with us to conduct this research. We have assisted the Census Bureau with several research studies in the past.
- O INTERVIEWS: An interviewer would conduct an interview with you. Because of the importance of this study, the interview needs to be face to face, but our interviewer can meet with you at a time and location convenient to you.
