Expedited Amendment Summary and Justification:

We request expedited review and approval of introduction scripts for the previously approved Supplemental Mental Health Questionnaire that will be administered to ~4,600 participants at the end of their follow-up telephone interview. The scripts inform the participant that they are eligible to complete the additional survey, will be invited to complete subsequent interviews, and that they will receive a \$10.00 for their additional time upon completion of these questions. A thank you letter and the gift card will be mailed to the participants within 2 weeks of completing the interview.
