Understanding the barriers of acquiring relying parties to NSTIC

BACKGROUND

The National Strategy for Trusted Identities (NSTIC) is a White House initiative signed by President Obama in 2011. The NSTIC envisions an Identity Ecosystem, where individuals and organizations utilize secure, efficient, easy-to-use, and interoperable identity credentials to access online services in a manner that promotes confidence, privacy, choice, and innovation. The Identity Ecosystem Steering Group (IDESG) is a private-sector led organization, funded by the NSTIC, that's facilitating the development of the Identity Ecosystem.

PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY

The Identity Ecosystem will be most successful if it has an abundance of Relying Parties (RPs) – organizations accepting 3rd party federated credentials from Service Providers for access to their services. Unfortunately, there is currently a dearth of organizations willing to act as RPs; this survey delves into this issue, seeking to further understand the barriers that prevent organizations from transitioning to this role.

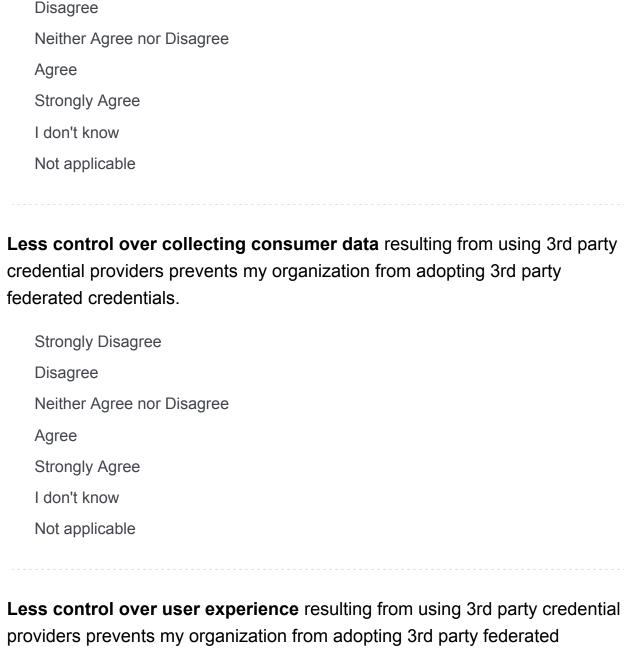
