Also includes officers who serve civil or criminal process, provide witness protection, courtroom security, or other activities related to the federal court system.

CORRECTIONS/DETENTION: Includes correctional officers, detention guards, and other personnel whose duties are primarily related to the custody, control, supervision, or transportation of pretrial detainees, prison inmates, or detained illegal aliens.

OTHER: Includes employees whose duties are primarily related to general support, administration, research and development, training, information systems, laboratory testing, domestic security intelligence, or any other function not included above.
