



FIGURE 5. Instructions & Help: Company Information



# **Product Name Shortened**

The shortened product name is built using the USDA standard for abbreviations. The abbreviations used for the shortened product name can be found in <a href="Appendix A of the USDA National Nutrient">Appendix A of the USDA National Nutrient</a> <a href="Database for Standard Reference">Database for Standard Reference</a>. The Product Name Shortened should not be an abbreviation of each word in the full product name but rather should be a clear and concise shortened version of the full product name.




FIGURE 7. Instructions & Help: Nutrient Information
