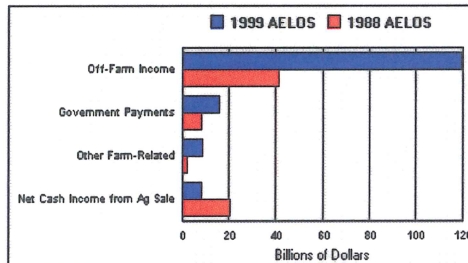
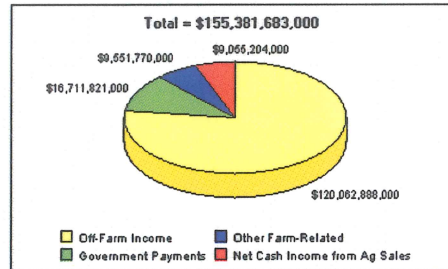

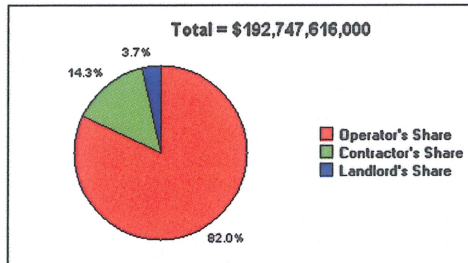
Although farm counts have stayed fairly stable at around 2 million for the past decade, there have been some significant changes on the economic structures of those farms.

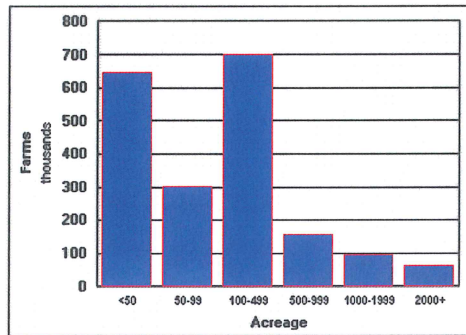
**TOTAL NET CASH INCOME**



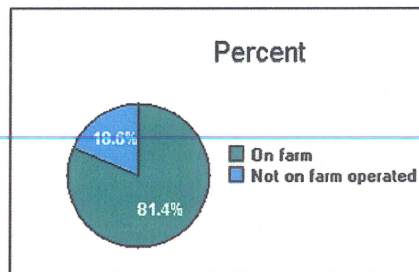
**MARKET VALUE OF AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS SOLD (Percentage)**



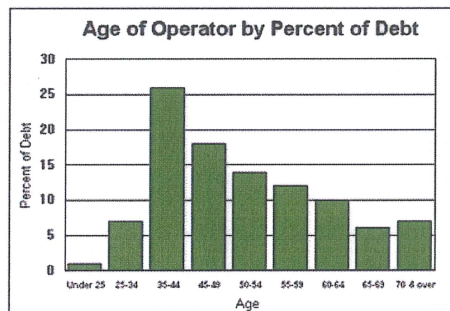
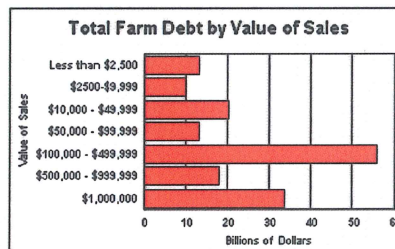
**FARMS WITH OFF-FARM INCOME (By Size of Farm)**



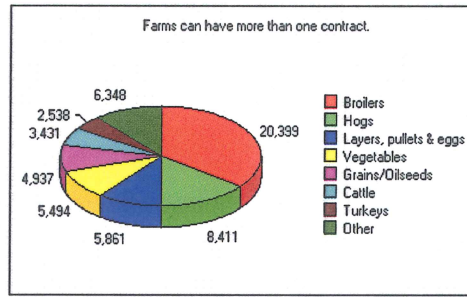
RESIDENCE OF OPERATOR



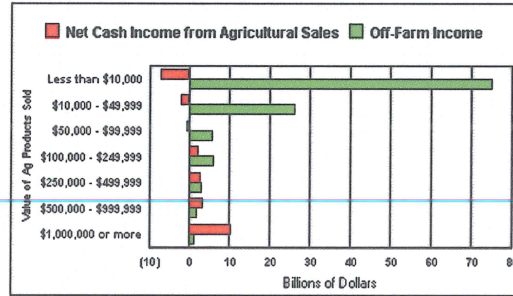
FARMS WITH DEBT
