1. C FACTS PSA

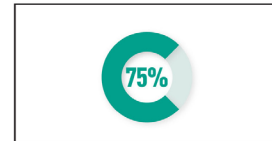
C Facts

:30 second PSA

In this spot, we see a letter 'C' animate and morph to visualize various facts and information about Hepatitis C. The animation is fluid and uses minimal visuals while a voice over goes into more detail about the subject.



LIGHT, UPBEAT MUSIC UP AND UNDER
VO: Were you born from **1945 - 1965**?
DATES CONDENSE TO FORM A C.



VO: So were **75%** of people with Hepatitis C.
'C' ANIMATES AND ADJUSTS TO SHOW A 75% PIE CHART.



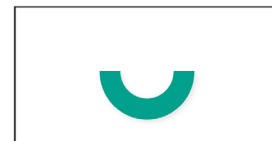
CURVE OF 'C' ANIMATES AND STRAIGHTENS OUT, BECOMING THE TOP OF THE NOTEPAD.
VO: A simple **blood test** is the only way to know for sure.
NOTE PAD PAGE FLIPS AWAY. THE 'C' FROM THE PAGE STAYS.



THE LETTERS 'ANCER' APPEAR NEXT TO THE 'C' TO SPELL CANCER.
VO: Hepatitis C is a serious liver disease and a leading cause of **liver cancer**.



'ANCER' DISAPPEARS AND IS REPLACED BY 'URABLE' TO FORM 'CURABLE'
VO: However **treatments are available** that can cure Hepatitis C
'URABLE' DISAPPEARS.

In this spot, we see a series of baby boomer talking heads stating important facts about Hepatitis C. As a new person appears, faces and messages overlap to give a sense of continuity and an awareness of the scope of Hepatitis C.

MORPH TO PERSON #3.



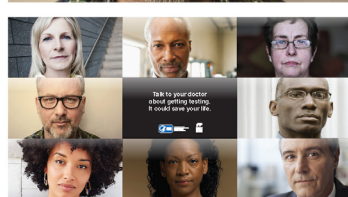
"...**5 times more likely to have Hepatitis C.**

VO: You can't see it.

VO: It doesn't make a sound.

IT IS PART OF A MOSAIC TITLE PATTERN ON A WALL.



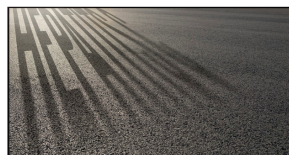
VO: And often, it gives no warning signs at all.

VO: Most people who have it were born from 1945 to 1965.

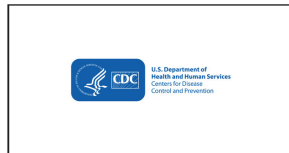
IT IS IN THE SHADOWS OF EVENING TWILIGHT.

Back in The Day

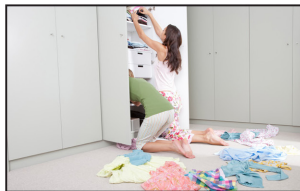

THE OTHER FRIEND TEASES HER BACK BY POINTING OUT A LOUD PATTERNED OUTFIT.

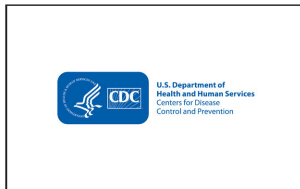
VO: Unlike the loud fashions of the 60's 70's & 80's, Hepatitis C is often silent with no symptoms.



THEY SHARE A LAUGH OVER AN IMPOSSIBLY HIGH PAIR OF PLATFORM SHOES.


VO: 3 out of 4 people who have Hepatitis C were born from 1945 to 1965. It's a leading cause of liver cancer.


