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

SUBJECT: Taxes Assessed in Fiscal Year 2013 on Department of Defense Contractors
Performing in Afghanistan

This memorandum requests your assistance to implement reporting requirements for section 1216 (c) of the National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) for Fiscal Year (FY) 2014 which requires the Secretary of Defense to submit a report on the total taxes assessed during FY 2013 by the Government of Afghanistan on all Department of Defense assistance.

Attached is a matrix of the DoD contractors with place of performance in Afghanistan and NIA code " OEF"and obligations greater than \$1M during FY 2013. A separate attachment is provided by component including vendors representing the greatest DoD obligation for the Department. This method of capturing the data will alleviate multiple components requesting data from the same vendor. You should only survey the U.S. vendors listed for your component so that they can report the total taxation assessed (by type) by the Government of Afghanistan, total taxation paid, total taxation assessed remaining unpaid, and the total taxation reimbursed in FY 2013. Report this data using the attached matrix no later than June 15, 2014 for consolidation into USD(AT&L)'s report to the Senate and the House Armed Services Committees.
