Most of the questions just require you to say 'yes' or 'no' to answer, and you may be asked for a month or year

as a response. As I told you before, the information you are providing will be kept private. Also remember that

you can skip questions that you don't want to answer and you can stop at anytime.

If at any time you do not feel physically or emotionally safe, you can just say "goodbye". I will understand and
