Priority Rule

Rural Development (RD) is requesting emergency review and approval for a new information collection, including approval to use a new form, RD 1980-88 to collect this information. This new information collection addresses application and reporting requirements for the Strategic Economic and Community Development rule being published on May 20, 2015. This rule implements a priority, authorized under Section 6025 of the Agricultural Act of 2014 (2014 Farm Bill), for projects that support strategic economic and community development plans. This priority affects a number of Rural Development programs.

We are requesting emergency approval because RD will not be able to implement this priority including the associated notice of solicitation of applications in Fiscal Year (FY) 2015, as the use of normal clearance procedures is reasonable likely to prevent or disrupt the collection of information from applicants to submit the new form with their application prior to the first deadline of June 30, 2015. The 60 day notice for comments is embedded in the rule. Due to the need to consider comments received and then issue another notice in the Federal Register for an additional thirty days of comment, RD would not be able to complete the information collection process before the deadline for applicants to receive these priority points in FY 2015.

RD considers it imperative to begin accepting applications this fiscal year for projects that support economic and community development plans. The regional economic development priority being implemented through the Section 6025 rule is an important priority to this Administration and the Secretary of Agriculture. In fact, on Wednesday at this week's 10th Annual Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) Rural Development Conference in Memphis, TN, Secretary Tom Vilsack leads the American delegation on behalf of the Obama Administration emphasizing that "Rural communities are critical for our economic future" and wherein the Secretary is planning an announcement on the Section 6025, Strategic Economic and Community Development rule.
