

Supporting Statement for OPM 1825

1. The Civilian Service Recognition Act of 2011 (Public Law 112-73) authorizes an agency to furnish a United States flag on behalf of an employee who dies of injuries incurred in connection with his/her employment under specified circumstances. OPM Form OPM 1825, Application for U.S. Flag Recognition Benefit for Deceased Federal Civilian Employees, may be used to determine deceased Federal employee and beneficiary (e.g., family member of a deceased employee) eligibility for issuance of a U.S. flag. The form may be used by any Federal entity and use of the form is at agency discretion. .
2. The employee and beneficiary information is collected on OPM 1825, and submitted to the agency to determine eligibility for issuance of the U.S. Flag. The agency retains the forms in their files.

Agencies equipped to accept electronic signatures may use an electronic version of the form.

3. Agencies equipped to accept electronic signatures may use an electronic version of the form. The form will be available for public printing. The results of the information collection will not be made available to the public over the Internet. OPM anticipates rate use of this optional form.
4. Various beneficiary forms may duplicate employee and beneficiary information requested on OPM 1825.
