**PURPOSE:** The Safe to Sleep® campaign (formerly Back to Sleep) was launched to raise the public's awareness of ways to reduce the risk of Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS) and to help inform all parents and infant care givers about the importance of back sleeping. The launch was supported by the *Eunice Kennedy Shriver* National Institute of Child Health and Human Development (NICHD) in collaboration with the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP), the SIDS Alliance (now First Candle/ SIDS Alliance), the Association of SIDS and Infant Mortality Programs (ASIP), and the Maternal and Child Health Bureau of the Health Resources Service Administration (HRSA).
