

Section 1602 - Annual Re

Under Section 1602 of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Tax Act of 2009 (Section 1602), state housing credit agencies use the funds to make subawards. The Section 1602 program temporarily fills the gap left by the state housing supply.

The Recovery Act encourages accountability and transparency in the use of funds. This annual report of compliance is in response to the requirement that state housing credit agencies submit reports to 1602Reports@do.treas.gov by July 1 each year until information is complete for all subawards (i.e., 15-year compliance period).
