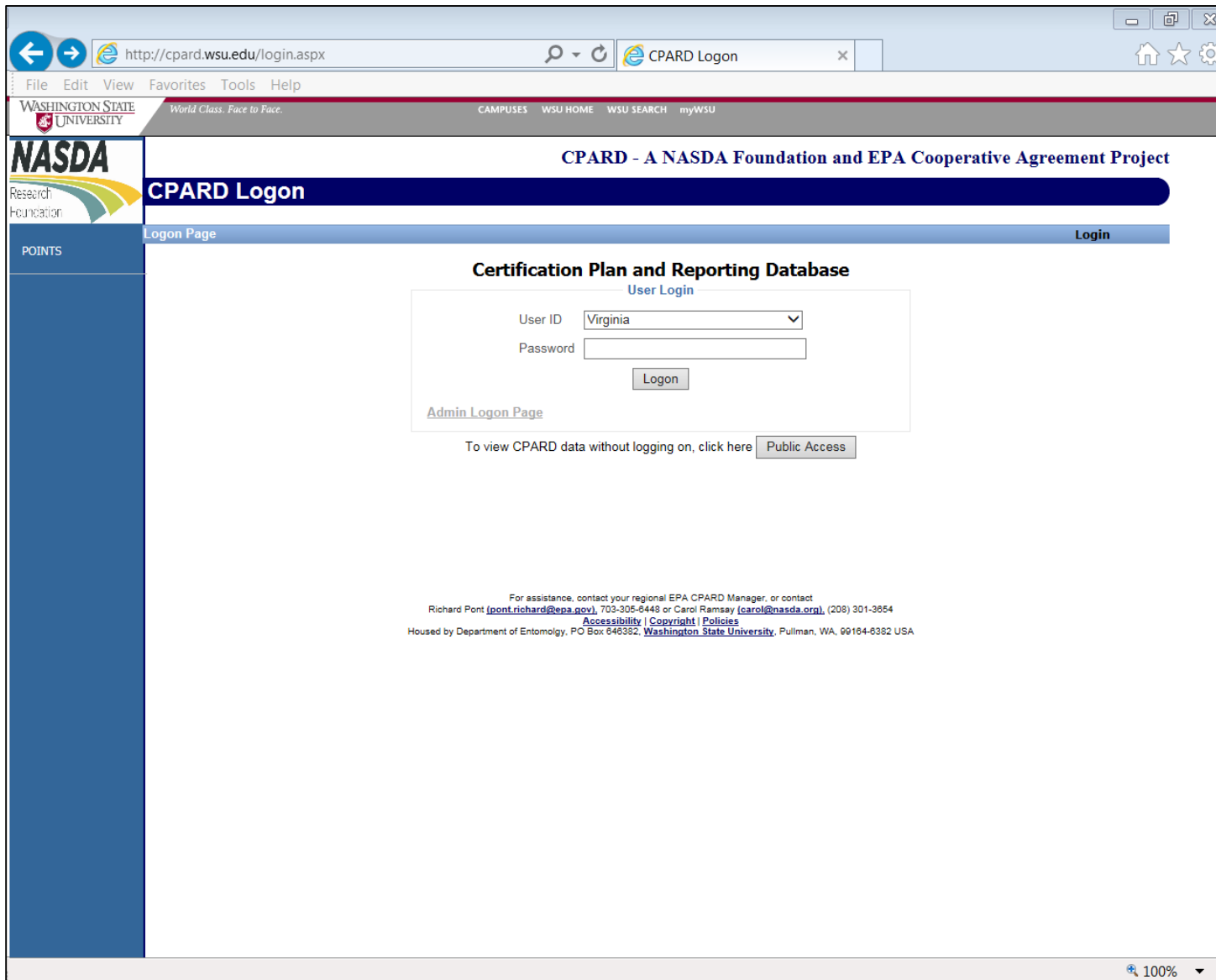


CPARD SCREEN SHOTS FOR ICR RENEWAL
