Section 9 of Title 13 guarantees that your **response is confidential**. Your information is only used to develop summary statistics that do not reveal the individual activities of your company. Applicable provisions of the law are provided at the website listed above. You may use reasonable estimates if book figures are not readily available.

The ACES collects capitalized spending for new and used structures and equipment. Summary data from this survey are an important source of information regarding U.S. economic performance. Business investment in structures and equipment is a key component of the official estimate of the Gross Domestic Product. The ACES data also help U.S. businesses identify market opportunities, develop new products, and conduct strategic planning.
