The U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) is pleased that you are participating in the E-Verify Program which is administered jointly by USCIS and the Social Security Administration. As part of an ongoing evaluation of E-Verify, USCIS is conducting a nationally representative survey on how employers perceive and use E-Verify for employment verification. We have authorized Westat, an independent social science consulting firm, to conduct the survey.

Assessing the effectiveness of E-Verify is an integral part of this program, as described in the Memorandum of Understanding that you signed when you registered to participate in the program.
