In accordance with title 5, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 1320.13, "Emergency Processing," the Department of Defense requests emergency processing and approval of a public information collection requirement. The purpose of this emergency submission is to be able to assess the ability of prospective purchases of DoD materiel to meet the responsibility criteria in part 102 of Title 41, Code of Federal Regulations and comply with applicable laws and regulations. Release of such property without clearance checks poses a risk to national security. The Paperwork Reduction Act submission package and the Statement of Determination have been uploaded into ROCIS.

The Department of Defense cannot reasonably comply with the normal clearance procedures under title 5, CFR, Part 1320. The use of normal procedures under title 5, CFR, Part 1320, is likely to delay or disrupt the collection of the information and impede the Department's ability to implement the Defense Materiel Disposition Interim Final Rule. The information collection is essential to the mission of the Department. Given this, the Department is requesting emergency approval by November 19, 2014.
