3. How useful do you find Global Dossier?

5. Which features need enhancement?
6. Does Global Dossier save you time?
 - a. Where does the time savings come?

 - ii. During prosecution?
7. Does Global Dossier save you money?

8. What could the USPTO and IP5 do to further improve the usefulness of Global Dossier?
9. One of the initiatives for Global Dossier is an XML provision. What are your thoughts on submitting applications to the Office in XML?
