The National Survey on Drug Use and Health (NSDUH) OMB No. 0930-0110, Exp. 07/31/19) includes this before the question “Not counting minor traffic violations, have you ever been arrested and booked for breaking the law?” No evidence that this was ever cognitively tested.
2. [If YES to arrested] How many times have you been arrested for a crime?  _____	Not on other surveys. NSDUH asks “Not counting minor traffic violations, how many times during the past 12 months have you been arrested and booked for breaking the law?” No evidence that this was ever cognitively tested.
3. Have you ever been incarcerated (in either jail or prison excluding juvenile detention)? Yes No	Not on other surveys. NSDUH asks “Were you on parole, supervised release, or other conditional release from prisons at any time during the past 12 months? National Survey of Family Growth (NSFG) OMB #0920-0314, Exp. 05/31/18) asks, “In the last 12 months, have you spent any time in a jail, prison, or a juvenile detention facility?” No evidence that this was ever cognitively tested.
