- If your firm operates storage facilities in more than one State, separate reports should be prepared for each State.
- Report total capacity and stocks of whole grains and oilseeds in storage facilities operated by your firm.
- **Include** both bulk and sacked capacity in the rated storage capacity.
- **Include** all whole grains and oilseeds stored in your facilities and/or piles (temporarily stored) regardless of ownership for farmers, elevators, millers, processors, farmer owned reserve, under loan, and the Government Commodity Credit Corporation. **Include** grain to be used for seed. **Include** both domestic and imported stocks.
- **Exclude** grain owned and/or stored at another licensed grain elevator.
