- <u>Justification #1</u>: Whenever we add new agreements, it increases the public burden accordingly. Previously, we reported the public burden as 417 annual burden hours based on 5,000 respondents taking 5 minutes to complete the form. Now we are raising the burden to 916 hours based on 11,000 respondents taking 5 minutes to complete the form:
