

**Justification for Non-Substantive Changes for

Revisions to the Collection Instrument

- **Change #1:** We are making the necessary burden changes to our OMB-approved International Direct Deposit (IDD) forms (SSA-1199) due to new IDD agreements with additional countries. Countries participating in new IDD agreements are:

- **Justification #1:** Whenever we add new agreements, it increases the public burden accordingly. Previously, we reported the public burden as 417 annual burden hours based on 5,000 respondents taking 5 minutes to complete the form. Now we are raising the burden to 916 hours based on 11,000 respondents taking 5 minutes to complete the form:

While we are increasing the burden to accommodate the new respondents, we will not need to revise the data elements we require, so those will remain the same.
