The information is maintained in accordance with the Privacy Act System of Records: National Wildlife Refuge Special Use Permits--Interior, FWS-5). False, fictitious, or fraudulent statements or representations made in the application may be grounds for revocation of the permit and maybe punishable by fine or imprisonment (18 U.S.C. 1001). Failure to provide all required information is sufficient cause for the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service to deny a permit. 3. This burden estimate includes time for reviewing instructions, gathering and maintaining data and completing and reviewing the form.
