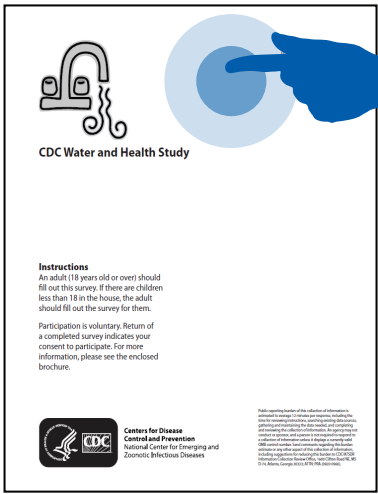

No matter what you use your tap water for—bathing, washing your hands, brushing your teeth, or drinking—we need to hear from you.

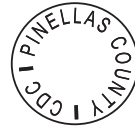
If you receive a survey, please take a few moments to complete it. Each and every response helps us understand the links between water use and health.
