Instructions

- Verify the company name, address, and industry description on page 1.
- Report each employee by occupation title. Report an employee who works in two or more occupations in the job that requires the highest skill level. If there is no measureable difference in skill, report the employee in the occupation in which they spend the most time.
- Report part-time workers at an hourly rate. Full-time workers can be reported by their annual or hourly rate.
- Return the completed form in the enclosed postage-paid envelope, or fax to (555) 555-1234.

EXAMPLE

How to Submit Data Electronically

Create a spreadsheet like the example above listing each employee on your payroll for the pay period including November 12, 2015, or extract a report from your payroll or personnel system. We will accept almost any file format. Do not include employee names or social security numbers. Please exclude contract workers.

Send your file to the secure email address on page 1, or go to our data collection site, <https://idcfoes.bls.gov>. You can securely upload your file or enter your data online.

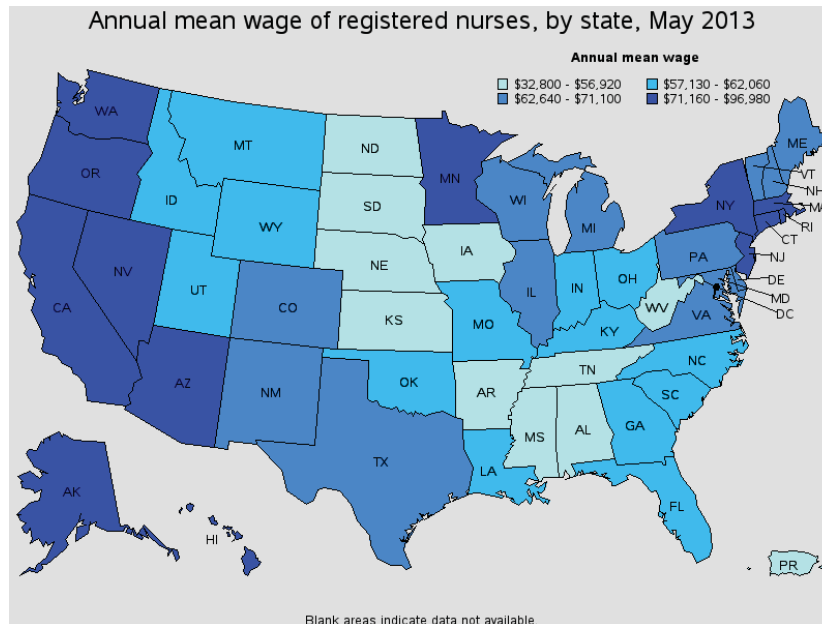
Statement to Respondents on the Use of Electronic Data Transmission
