- 1. *Intended purpose* Determine the schools satisfaction with the experiment, Federal Student Aid's (FSA) management of the experiment, and the anticipated closeout of the experiment.
- 2. *Need for the collection* The experiment allowed participating schools to make unequal disbursements of Direct Loans during the 2015-16 award year by relaxing specific regulations in order to determine if better outcomes can be achieved. The Department decided to end this experiment after the 2016-17 award year and now has the need to assess how well it is assisting participating schools in transitioning back to regular rules governing the delivery of federal student aid.
- 3. *Planned use of the data* Allow FSA to assess the scope of satisfaction of communications, support and closeout procedures provided to the schools that participated in the experiment.

- 7. *Description of respondents* The twelve postsecondary schools that participated in the experiment.
