OPIC can provide financing for overseas investments that are wholly owned by U.S. companies or, at a minimum, have an ownership interest of at least 25 percent. If your project does not meet this US investment requirement, you may still be able to find financing through one of the Network Lenders

OPIC will require the project sponsors show a healthy track record, and have significant experience in and knowledge of the host country, market and environment

Q6 Help Message:

OPIC provides medium- to long-term funding through direct loans and loan guaranties to eligible investment projects in developing countries and emerging markets. OPIC loan terms typically range from three to fifteen years, with market rates of interest, and customary financing costs and fees borne by the borrower. OPIC does not make direct equity investments in projects. OPIC political risk insurance is available to U.S. investors, contractors, exporters and financial institutions involved in international transactions. Network Lenders are also a potential source of debt funding. We recommend consulting an EDN Originator to determine the appropriate type of funding for your project.

Q7 Help Message:

OPIC will require you to contact private banks and insurers to gauge their willingness to participate in your project. If you have done so, and if private sector banks and/or insurers have expressed their unwillingness to work with you, then OPIC may be able to support your project.
