Instructions for I-907, Request for Premium Processing Service

NOTE: You may file Form I-907 electronically. Go to our Internet Web site at www.uscis.gov and follow the detailed instructions on e-filing.

Instructions

Read these instructions carefully to properly complete this form. If you need more space to complete an answer, use a separate sheet of paper. Write your name and Alien Registration Number (A-Number), if any, at the top of each sheet of paper and indicate the section and number of the item to which the answer refers.

What Is the Purpose of This Form?

Use Form I-907 to request Premium Processing Service on certain petitions or applications designated as eligible for this service.

When Should I Use Form I-907?

You should use Form I-907 to request Premium Processing Service for certain petitions or applications designated as eligible for Premium Processing Service. Visit our Web site at www.uscis.gov for details about which petitions or applications are eligible for this service.

You may file your request for Premium Processing Service with the eligible petition or application. You may also file the request for Premium Processing Service after you file the eligible petition or application, as long as the eligible petition or application is still pending.

Only the petitioner or applicant who filed the corresponding petition or application (e.g. Form I-129), or the attorney or accredited representative of the petitioner or applicant, may request Premium Processing Service. If the attorney or accredited representative makes the request, a properly completed Form G-28, Notice of Entry of Appearance as Attorney or Representative, must accompany the request, unless the attorney or accredited representative has already filed Form G-28 in the case. Form G-28 filed with Form I-907 by a new attorney or accredited representative will replace Form G-28 filed with the underlying petition or application, and the new attorney will be recognized as the attorney of record in the case.

Premium Processing Service guarantees 15-calendar-day processing of certain employment-based petitions or applications. U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) will refund the Premium Processing Service fee but continue to process the case unless, within 15 calendar days of receipt of a properly filed Form I-907, USCIS issues an

approval notice or, where appropriate, issues a notice of intent to deny a request for evidence, or opens an investigation for suspected fraud or misrepresentation on the related petition or application.

The processing time has been met if an intent to deny or request for evidence is issued within 15 calendar days of receipt or if the case is referred for investigation of suspected fraud or misrepresentation. Once USCIS receives a response to the notice of intent to deny or request for evidence, USCIS will guarantee 15-calendar-day processing from the date the response was received.

General Instructions

How Do I File Form I-907?

You must fill out a separate Form I-907 for each petition or application submitted. Follow the steps below to complete your request process:

Step 1 - Fill Out Form I-907

Step 2 - Submit Your Request

NOTE: USCIS wants to make sure that you receive the requested immigration benefit. To do this, we may ask for more evidence, interview you, and/or conduct an investigation.

Step 1. Fill Out Form I-907

Use black ink only. Type or print clearly using CAPITAL letters. If an item does not apply to you, write "N/A." If the answer is none, write "NONE."

This form is divided into Parts 1 through 4. The following information will help you fill out the form.

Part 1 - Information About You

Company or Business Name - Give the full name of the company or business.

NOTE: Do not submit a change of address request to USCIS Lockbox facilities because USCIS Lockbox facilities do not process change of address requests.

As an alternative to waiting in line for assistance at your local USCIS office, you can now schedule an appointment through our Internet-based system, **InfoPass**. To access the system, visit our Web site. Use the **InfoPass** appointment scheduler and follow the screen prompts to set up your appointment. **InfoPass** generates an electronic appointment notice that appears on the screen.

Penalties

If you knowingly and willfully falsify or conceal a material fact or submit a false document with your Form I-907, we will deny your Form I-907 and may deny any other immigration benefit.

In addition, you will face severe penalties provided by law and may be subject to criminal prosecution.

Privacy Act Notice

We ask for the information on this form, and associated evidence, to determine if you have established eligibility for the immigration benefit for which you are filing. Our legal right to ask for this information can be found in the Immigration and Nationality Act, as amended. We may provide this information to other government agencies. Failure to provide this information, and any requested evidence, may delay a final decision or result in denial of your Form I-907.

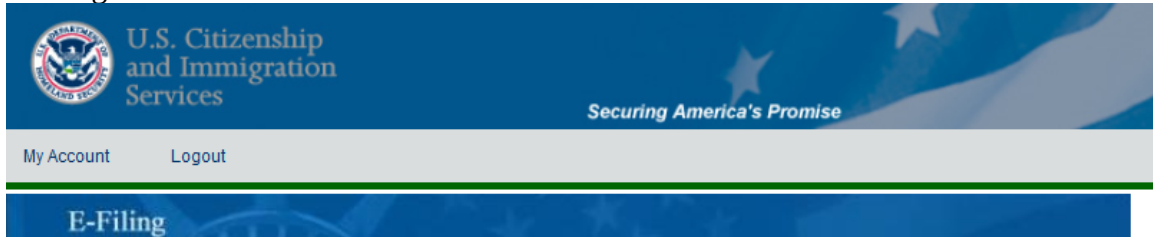

Pursuant to Title 8 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Section 103.7 and Section 103.2 respectively, filing and other applicable fees associated with USCIS applications, where applicable, "are non-refundable and must be paid when the application is filed."

No refund or returns will be honored for user errors or in the event of an application cancellation or withdrawal request. All requests for refunds must go through USCIS. USCIS will ONLY refund your fee if you paid more than once for the same immigrant. If this situation applies to you, contact USCIS at 1-800-375-5283 for information on how to file a refund request. A refund will also be issued in the event the USCIS does not meet the guaranteed 15 calendar day processing period for premium processing, under the specified conditions pursuant to Section 103.2 of Title 8 or due to a USCIS error (as identified in the CFR Section 103.7). There is a charge in the amount of \$30 imposed on the Payor of the filed application if the total amount due cannot be honored on the bank or cardholder on which the funds are drawn. This charge is separate from any other bank or credit card penalty charges that may be imposed by the issuing payor bank or credit card merchant.
