PERSONS ELIGIBLE TO VOTE: Any person who is currently a fresh market potato producer in the production area and produced such potatoes during the representative period, 20 through, 20 is entitled to cast one Ballot. Each separate business unit, partnership, LLC, family enterprise, corporation, association, estate, or firm is entitled to one vote.
	 "Producer" means any individual, partnership, LLC, corporation, association, institution, estate, or other business unit who: Owns and farms land resulting in ownership of the potatoes produced thereon; Rents and farms land resulting in ownership of all or a portion of the potatoes produced thereon; or Owns land from which, as rental for such land, ownership is obtained of a portion of the potatoes produced thereon. (A lien holder, cash landlord, or person having only a financial interest in the potato crop is not eligible to vote.)
