An environmental scan/situational analysis including available secondary audience research will be conducted focusing on the view of both people meeting clasification criteria for SLE of research among these groups to develop concepts and channels that will be used to create materials and plans for sex-and race/ethnic specific educational campaigns to address any identified gaps.
