NISVS-3 Questionnaire - Cognitive Study Protocol

COGNITIVE STUDY INTRODUCTION:

Thank you for participating in this study. In this interview, we're not just interested in your answers to these questions; we are interested in what you think about the questions. We want to make sure the questions make sense and that you are familiar with all the words we use. So, after some of the questions, we may ask you additional follow-up items, such as "tell me in your own words what this question is asking" or "Was it easy or hard to come up with your answer?" This will help us determine if we are asking the right questions.

Even though some of our questions may make it sound like we are giving you a test, there are no right or wrong answers to these questions. Our main goal is to make sure that the questions are understandable. While I'm only going to ask follow-up items on a few questions, you can help us by pointing out any questions you find confusing or unclear. That way we can fix these problems before we use these questions in the future. Also, if you think a question could be understood in more than one way, that is useful for us to know as well because we'd like everyone we interview to interpret our questions in the same way.

PROBE 3: *We switched directions and topics a lot in this survey. How easy or difficult was it for you to follow along and answer the questions?*

PROBE 4: *Were there any questions I asked that were confusing or unclear to you?*

PROBE 5: *Were there any questions you think I should have asked about, but I didn't?*

PROBE 6: *Did any of the questions seem repetitive, like you had already answered them? Which ones?*

PROBE 7: *The current order of the survey first asks about stalking, then sexual violence, then physical violence. Do you have any concerns about the order in which these sections were asked?*
