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Protect Yourself During Sex

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How Zika is spread through sex

- A man with Zika virus can pass it to his sex partners during vaginal, anal, or oral (mouth-to-penis) sex without a condom.
- You can get Zika from sex with a male partner before his symptoms start, while he has symptoms, and after
- Men with Zika who never develop symptoms may also be able to pass the virus to their sex partners.
- We don't know how long Zika virus can stay in the semen of infected men or how long it can be passed to sex
- We don't know if a woman with Zika can pass the virus to her sex partners during vaginal or oral (mouth-to-
